 2) 30 hours of course work (10 courses) plus a Master's thesis.

- Note:*
1. At least half of the semester hours must be in courses numbered 6000 or above.
 2. No more than six hours evaluated as C may be counted toward the minimum hours required for the master's degree.
 3. Generally, no more than six semester hours of transferred credit are accepted toward a master's degree, and such courses "are subject to the same time limitation as courses taken in residence," i.e., they must have been taken within six years of the first semester of enrollment in the M.A. They cannot be courses that have been counted toward a previous degree.
 4. Three hours (equivalent to one course) in a related area may be applied toward the M.A. in Spanish.

The Master of Arts degree in Spanish for Track II, TTS, requires completion of the following core courses:

- 1) One course in Spanish linguistics
- 2) One course in Spanish literature
- 3) One course in Spanish American literature
- 4) One course in Spanish or Spanish American civilization and culture
